- Working with the appropriate organisations to improve standards.
- Passing details to appropriate law enforcement bodies.

We regularly monitor our risks in this area and will continue to take action to embed a zero-tolerance policy towards modern slavery.

KPI Recruiting are members of strong together, we work collaboratively together to reduce forced labour, labour trafficking and other hidden third-party labour exploitation of workers in supply chains.
